<p>Prayer or Relief Sought</p> <p>Respected Sir,</p> <p>Appellant emphasise his first appeal on the below mentioned point :-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. That the appellant filed an RTI on dated 28-05-2022 to East Central Railway. 2. Appellant received a reply of respected CPIO on dated :- 07.06.2022. 3. In his reply CPIO stated that the Information asked is related to third party, hence it is not permitted under the RTI Act. 4. Here appellant admit that the point number 2, point number 3, and point number 4 is related to third party information, so appellant does not want

to go for appeal for these points.

5. But in point number 1, appellant sought the information that, in the month of April 2022, how many seats were allotted or number of passengers travelled under VIP Quota/Emergency Quota in Sleeper Class, 3AC, 2AC, in PNBE LTT Express.

6. So in point number 1 appellant only sought the information related to number of travellers travelled in VIP/Emergency Quota in the month of April 2022.

7. Here point number 1 does not related to any third party information because no personal information is sought. Only the numbers of passengers travelled is sought in point number 1.

8. So disclosing the number of travellers travelled under VIP/Emergency Quota in the month of April 2022 is justified and does not comes under any exemptions mentioned in RTI Act.

So appellant requested to First Appellate Authority to kindly direct the respected CPIO to provide the information sought in Point number 1.
