Respected Sir,

Appellant emphasise his First Appeal on below mentioned grounds :-

- 1. Appellant filed an RTI bearing number MEAAB/R/E/22/00007 on dated 27-06-2022.
- 2. Appellant received the reply of the CPIO on dated 21-07-2022.
- 3. Appellant satisfied with the reply of point number 1 and point number 3. Hence no appeal for point number 1 and 3.
- 4. In Point Number 2 Appellant asked about the "Details of expenditure incurred on food of High Commission Officials in the year 2021-2022, and the

answer of the CPIO for this point is NIL.

- 5. This is not the correct way to answer. Nor is this answer according to the standards of Central Information Commission and Right to Information Act 2005. The CPIO will have to state the reason for the non availability of record in the reply.
- 6. And it is also not possible that the Employees/Officers of the Embassy did not eat food in the year 2021 2022.
- 7. In point number 4 Appellant asked about the "Details of expenditure incurred on official International travel of High Commission officials in the year 2021-2022. (Outside Nigeria).
- 8. Point number 4 was exactly the same as point number 3. Point No. 3 asked for the cost of official domestic travel which took place within Nigeria border and Point No. 4 asked for the cost of official travel that was done by the Officials/Employees outside Nigeria.
- 9. It is a matter of great regret that point 3 was answered by the CPIO by understanding it. But the CPIO failed to understand point 4, that's why he refused to answer by saying that the question is vague.
- 10. In point number 5 Appellant asked about the "Details of expenditure incurred on the travel of High Commission Officials while going on leave in the year 2021-2022.
- 11. Here again the respected CPIO failed to understand the point. The only detail asked in point number 5 is when the Employees/Officers go on leave to their homes, how much was spent by the High Commission on their travel in the years 2021 and 2022.
- 12. The language of the RTI was so simple that even a fifth grade child could understand it easily. But respected CPIO failed to understand this language.

Therefore Appellant requests the First Appellate Authority to take cognizance of this First Appeal and direct the CPIO to provide the information sought in Point number 2,4 and 5.
